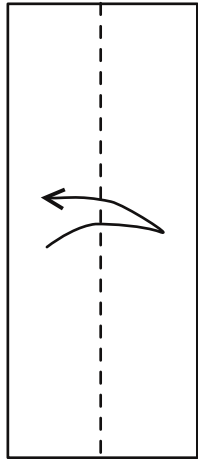


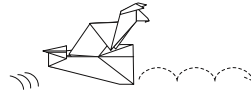
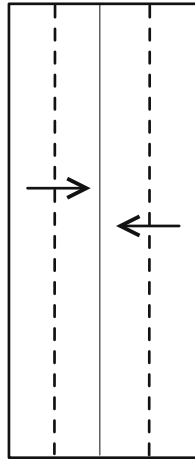
# Jumping Kangaroo

Start with a sheet of brown or grey paper (or lightweight card) of dimensions 21cm x 8.7cm. This is made by cutting a square off an A4 sheet. Otherwise you may use a Dollar Bill, which is of the same proportions. If using paper with a different colour each side, start with the brown/grey side facing down.

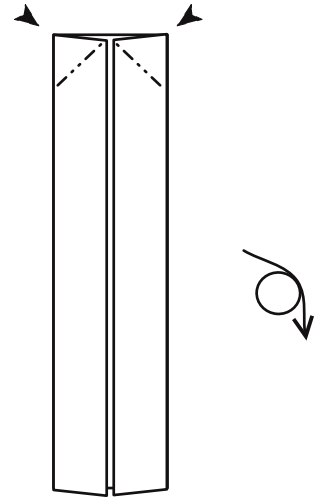
(1) Crease centre line



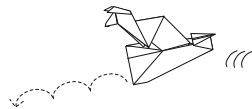
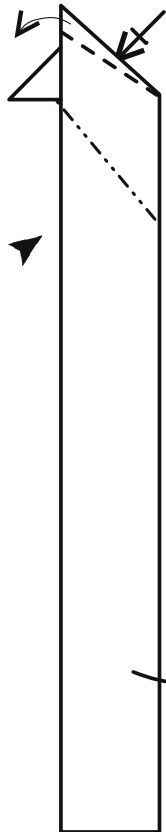
(2) Valley in sides



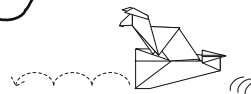
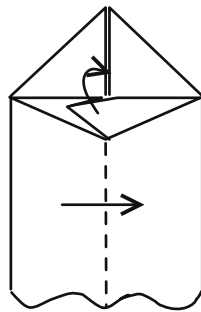
(3) Reverse in top corners. Turn over.



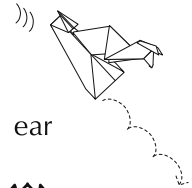
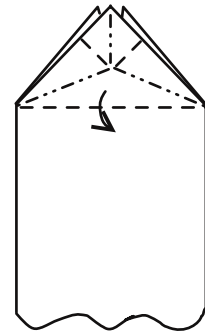
(6) Valley top points to form ears. Inside reverse long point up to the right at approx 45 degrees.



(5) Valley model in half, slotting rabbit's ear between top points.



(4) Make rabbit's ear on top point



(7) Mountain fold over neck flaps in front and behind. This locks ears in place. Small reverse fold forms nose.
